**What They Have Accomplished:**

The establishment of the first class for Cerebral Palsied children within the public schools in the State, outside of the City of Baltimore.  
The broadening of the State law to include all handicapped children, with increased funds to the counties.  
Through funds raised by the Ladies of the Elks of Silver Spring, a station wagon was purchased and donated to the Montgomery County Cerebral Palsy Association who turned it over to the Board of Education for the transportation of crippled children.

**What They Hope to Do:**

Cooperate with existing government and private agencies wherever possible and to supplement existing programs.

**Their Immediate Needs:**

Their most immediate needs are for speech instruction, physical therapy, and supplementing of transportation facilities.
