

Brethren:

The level an emblem of equality. In the sight of God, who alone is great, all men are equal, subject to the same infirmities, hastening to the same goal, and preparing to be judged by the same immutable law. In this sense only do masons speak of the equality which should rein in the Lodge; but as "peaceable subjects to the civil power," they deny the existence of that revolutionary equality, which, levelling all distinctions of rank, would tend to beget confusion, insubordination, and anarchy in the state.

The level is one of the working tools of a fellow craft, admonishing him, by its peculiar uses, of that vast level of time on which all men are travelling, to its limits in eternity.

The level is also the jewel worn by the Senior Warden, as the distinctive badge of his office, reminding him that while he presides over the labors of the lodge, as the Junior Warden does over the refreshments, it is his duty to see that every brother meets upon the level, and that the principles of equality is preserved during the work, without which, harmony, the chief support of our institution, could not be preserved.

On Thursday, April 6, 1972, Shekinah Lodge No. 58 will travel to Brotherhood Lodge No. 292 to present them with the traveling gavel.
