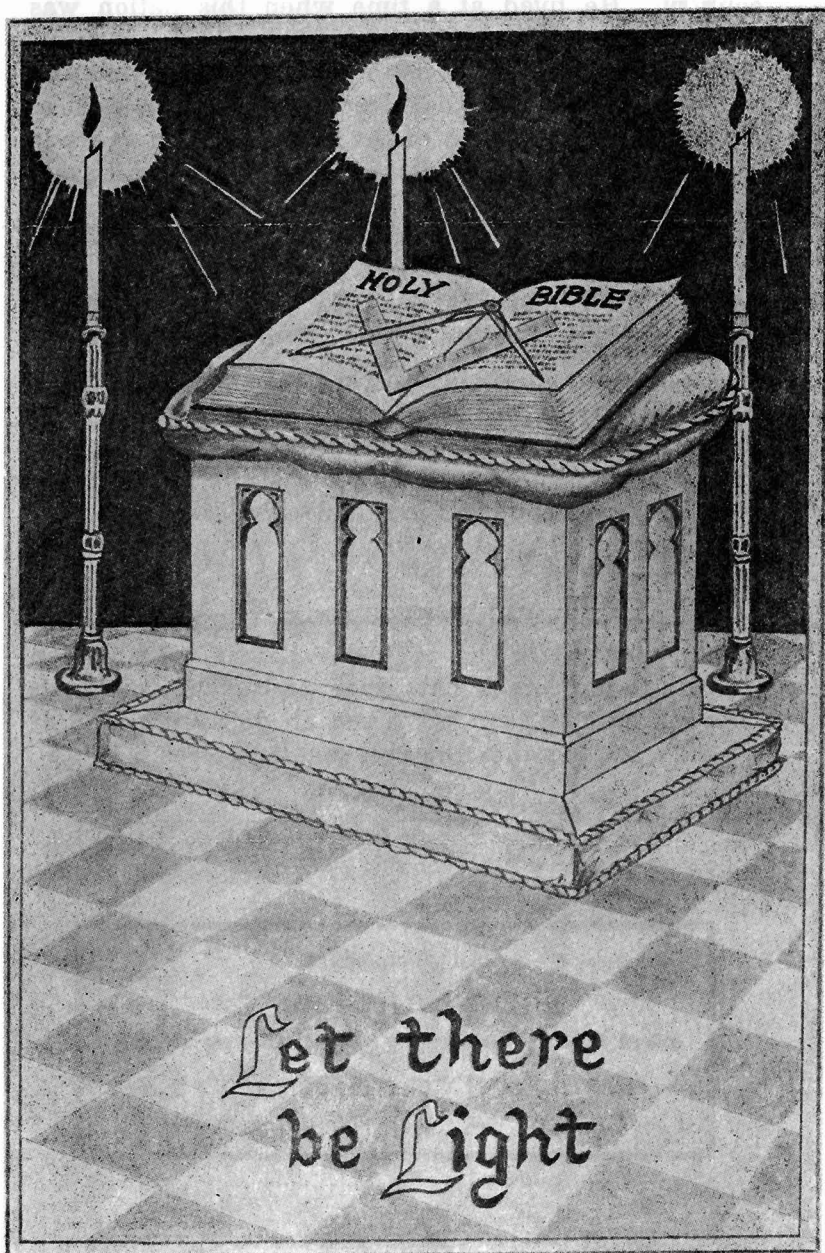


# SHEKINAH LODGE No. 58

He lived at a time when this nation was taking shape and, as presiding officer of the constitutional convention, he no doubt gave a mighty impulse to Masonic life.
