
# Shekinah Lodge, No. 58

# Free and Accepted Masons Millville, New Jersey

Instituted - May 21, 1861



Brethren:

Thirdly, when a brother intrusts to our keeping the secret thoughts of his bosom, prudence and fidelity should place a sacred seal upon our lips, least, in an ungarded moment, we betray the solem trust confided to our honor.

Fourthly, when adversity has visited our brother, and his calamities call for our aid, we should cheerfully and liberally stretch forth the hand of kindness, to save him from sinking, and to relieve his necessities.

Fifthly, while with candour and kindness we should admonish a brother of his faults, we should never revile his characted behind his back, but rather, when attacked by others, support and defend it.
