
# SHEKINAH LODGE No. 58

#### Brethren:

When you received your 1971 dues card, you may or may not have noticed that the year was printed in large numbers on the face. This date was filled in by the secretary in the past, and when a newly raised brother was presented with his card, he still owed his yearly dues in addition to the initiation fee he had already paid. Or a total of \$125.00 to be paid in two payments by the annual communication in December. These payments were \$110, initiation and \$15, dues. Since these new dues cards intimate that the brother is paid up to December, it has been recommended that we now charge a flat \$125.00 fee at initiation. In this way the new brother will not be presented with another bill for the yearly dues. There is no increase in total; but when informing a petitioner what his initiation fee will be, kindly advise him of the new amount.
