"Then Abram moved his tent and came and dwelt by the oaks of Mamre, which are in Hebron, and there built an altar to the Lord." Genesis 13:18 (NAS)

## Brethren:

Through his life, Abraham built his altars first, and then his wells. His son Issac, however, built his wells first and ran into trouble when the locals tried to reclaim them. Consequently, he spent a great deal of time trying to find a well to call his own; and then he built an altar to the Lord (Genesis 26). I wonder if Isaac would have had so much conflict over those wells had be built his altar first?

Over and over in the Scriptures, whatever his circumstances. we find Abraham building his altars first. This man of God recognized that his spiritual duties were more important than his temporal tasks.

How often do we find ourselves entering into a great and important undertaking without first evoking the blessing of Deity? It's a lesson we need to work on in life; to learn to give priority to God's concerns instead of our own. The Grand Artificer of the Universe can make well digging a whole lot easier.
