One morning I was feeling overwhelmed by all the needs around me. The poor, the homeless, the flood victims ... there seemed to be so little one person could do. But after breakfast I opened the newspaper and read about a group in Maryland who were raising funds for a project by getting groups of people to save pennies.

Pennies buy so little today that many people will not even bother to pick one up if it is dropped. But this group figured out that there are sixteen pennies in one foot. Therefore, a mile of pennies would be worth \$844.80. People brought pennies in boxes and jars. They cleaned out purses, pockets and dresser drawers. And many small pennies added up to thousands of dollars as each person helped.

Their example encouraged me. I am but one and cannot do a lot by myself. But the story of the pennies reminded me of some lines written by Edward Everett Hale:

I am only one,
But still I am one.
I cannot do everything.
But still I can do something.
And because I cannot do everything.
I will not refuse to do the something that I can do.

If as members of Shekinah, we remember these words when we start filling in our calendar for the month, that beautiful big lodge room of ours wouldn't be empty as it is on meeting nights.
