

**Charles W. Hartman, Jr. MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP
Awarded by Springfield Lodge #4 AF & AM**



Charles W. Hartman, Jr. was a member of Springfield Lodge #4 AF & AM of Springfield, Illinois who firmly believed that education was one of the most important means to better a person. Upon his death in 1997, Springfield Lodge dedicated the Scholarship fund in his memory and established the criteria to award this scholarship to deserving students pursuing their education.

The Scholarship Committee reviewing each application will determine eligibility in several categories. Your previous school records, grades, activities, organizational involvement, planning for your future, and of course, financial need will be reviewed for final determination. Masonic Family affiliations will help in your consideration.

This Scholarship will be for a minimum of \$500, and will be awarded yearly. Reapplication will be necessary for anyone wanting to be considered for a subsequent year award. Award monies will be sent either to the student or the school the student is attending depending on answers given in the application process and information gathered by the Committee.

A Masonic Sponsor is not required, but should one be known to the applicant, have them fill out the appropriate section on the application and sign accordingly. Not having a sponsor will not affect the eligibility of the application.

A short biography is required in addition to your most recent school transcripts. This biography should be between 300 and 500 words following the directions on the application. Make sure you answer all questions as clearly and concisely as possible. Please note anything as "not applicable" clearly so there will be no confusion during the review process.

Applications must be received by **JULY 1**, to be considered for the next school year.
