Scholarship Program

Lodge Le Progres de l'Océanie, a charitable fraternity, is offering four (4) \$2,500 Scholarships to be awarded in August, 2009. The prestigious *King David Kalakaua and King Kamehameha IV Past Masters Scholarship Award* may be renewed annually for up to four years upon proof of satisfactory progress. The four year award may be used for undergraduate, graduate, or professional school tuition, books, and/or supplies. These scholarships are intended to provide an opportunity for students striving to overcome a disadvantaged past and to pursue higher education. There are no age restrictions.

Eligibility

The applicant must:

- Be a resident of Hawaii
- Have a high school diploma or a general education diploma (GED)
- Be enrolled in an accredited university, community college, business school, or vocational school located in Hawaii.
- To renew a GPA of 3.0 or above

Important Dates

- The last day for application to be renewed shall be July 30th, 2009.
- Recipients shall be notified of awards approximately mid August, 2009.
- The formal presentation of awards will occur at an Awards Ceremony to be scheduled.

Application Forms and Application

Applicants desiring to apply shall submit a packet containing the following materials:

- Completed Application Form.
- Proof of attendance at an accredited institution of higher learning.
- One page essay stating reasons for pursuing higher education and what disadvantage the applicant has overcome.
